Dear Mr. Cowen:

As you know, the IAM has petitioned to represent a unit of employees at your facility. Regulations of the National Labor Relations Board ("NLRB") will require you to serve a voter eligibility list upon the Union and the NLRB within two business days of either the approval of an election agreement or the issuance of a decision and direction of election. The regulations further require that the list include certain personal information for each eligible voter – including home addresses and personal phone numbers and personal email addresses, if available. The Union, however, out of respect for the privacy of unit members, is willing to waive its right to receive such personal information. The Union therefore respectfully requests that the copy of the voter eligibility list served upon the Union *not* contain any of the aforementioned personal information.
